

Next Sunday, we will celebrate Mother's Day. A **Pastor's** mother is a female who brings up and raises her child with care and affection. She may or may not have given birth to the child she is entrusted to rear. She is a female parent. Mothers nurture

and care for children. Mothers are selfless, loving females who must sacrifice many of their wants and needs for the wants and needs of their children. A mother works hard to make sure her child is equipped with knowledge and skills and abilities to make life worthwhile and meaningful.

Mother's day is a celebration which is utilized to honor mothers of individual families, as well as motherhood in general. It is celebrated in many different cultures and is usually observed in March or May. In America, we celebrate it in May, usually the second Sunday of May. It is a time when we honor our mothers with gifts, meals, and special projects. Every part of the observance is to show our deep and abiding affection for all that our mothers have done for us.

Mother's Day is a time when we reflect on who we want to be as a family and how we are connected to one another. That connection is most often dictated by how our mothers impact and invest in us as well as our families. In America, the first Mother's Day observance was on May 12, 1907, when Anna Jarvis held a memorial service honoring her late mother in Grafton, West Virginia.

Jesus honored his mother at the Cross when he was dying and he gave charge for his mother to John. In John 19:26-27, "When Jesus saw His mother there, and the disciple whom he loved standing nearby, He said to her, 'Woman, here is your son,' and to the disciple, 'Here is your mother." From that time on, this disciple took her into his home." Jesus was entrusting John to care for His mother in his home from that time forward.

It is fitting that we should follow suit and honor our mothers. Sunday we will have Parent-Child Dedication and an honoring of our mothers. As I think of my mother, I am reminded of an incredible Prayer Warrior and one of the people who introduced me to Jesus. My mom taught me that I needed Jesus and how to pray and she also taught me how to share the Gospel of Jesus with others. I will ever be indebted to my mother. Without her and without her influence, I would be nothing.
